reasonable attorneys' fees and costs as provided for in the Promissory Note which was the basis of ThinLinx Complaint, under Code of Civil Procedure §1717(a), the amount of such attorneys' fees were proven by a post-judgment motion for award of attorneys' fees in the amount of \$30,968.00 and such costs were established by a post-judgment memorandum of costs in the amount of \$1,657.00.

## JUDGMENT ON THE CROSS-COMPLAINT

- 3. Summary Judgment having been granted to Cross-complainant Jay Sorg against Crossdefendant ThinLinx, Inc. on the first cause of action of the Cross-complaint for Failure to Pay Minimum Wage for liquidated damages under Labor Code §§558 and 1194.2 in the total amount of \$4,423.50, judgment is entered in favor of Cross-complainant in that amount.
- Summary Judgment having been granted to Cross-complainant Jay Sorg against Cross-4. defendant ThinLinx, Inc. on the third cause of action of the Cross-complaint for Breach of Implied-In-Law Contract for unpaid wages in the amount of \$20,000.00 which were and owing and unpaid as of October 31, 2015 and in the amount of \$2,250.00 which were owing and unpaid as of October 31, 2015, judgment is entered in favor of Cross-complainant on that cause of action for a total amount of such wages of \$22,250.00.
- Summary Judgment having been granted to Cross-complainant Jay Sorg against Cross-5. defendant ThinLinx, Inc. on the fifth cause of action of the Cross-complaint for Failure to Timely Pay All Wages Due in violation of Labor Code §203 for penalties for failure to pay such wages in the amount of \$5,825.00, judgment is entered in favor of Cross-complainant on that cause of action in that amount.
- Summary Judgment having been granted to Cross-complainant Jay Sorg against Crossdefendant ThinLinx, Inc. on the sixth cause of action of the Cross-complaint for Failure to Properly Itemize Wage Statements under California Labor Code §226(a) in the amount of \$1,050.00, judgment is entered in favor of Cross-complainant on that cause of action in that amount.
- Summary Judgment having been granted to Cross-complainant Jay Sorg against Cross-7. defendant ThinLinx, Inc. on the seventh cause of action of the Cross-complaint for Unfair Competition under Business and Professions Code §16600 and 17200, judgment is entered in favor of Cross-complainant on that cause of action.

9. Summary judgment was granted awarding interest to Cross-complainant Jay Sorg on the above amounts at the rate of ten percent (10%) simple interest per year under Labor Code §218.6 and Civil Code §3289 in the total amount of \$13,669.74 as of the March 28, 2019 hearing date on the Motion for Summary Judgment and judgment is entered in favor of Cross-complainant for interest in that amount accrued on or before March 28, 2019.

The total judgment awarded to Cross-complainant Jay Sorg on his First, Third, Fifth and Sixth Causes of Action of the Cross-complaint is \$33,548.50 plus interest in the amount of \$13,669.74 accrued as of March 28, 2019. Judgment is also awarded to Cross-complainant Jay Sorg for unpaid sanctions in the amount of \$1,000.00.
